Paul explained that as Christians (followers of Christ) that walk in the flesh, do not wage war according to the flesh. For instance, addictions, generational curses, violence, emotional and physical abuse, rejection from family and society, and mental health issue like depression and PTSD of a tragic event.

The children of God do not have to suffer by themselves or take on warfares alone because they are covered by the blood of Jesus. Allow the holy spirit to fight the battles because fighting them by the flesh can only lead to bigger problems. Strong people have fallen walking in the flesh.
