Run And Tell That

People are sometimes quick to share news they think will have a great impact on those they share that news with. Perhaps, they have watched the latest news and heard about another school shooting, or a celebrity died, or another innocent person was killed at a traffic stop. They are eager to share and discuss that news. Mary Magdalene, early Sunday morning, discovered that Jesus was not in the tomb.
