Don't Worry, You Have A Guide.

When embarking upon uncharted territory, it would feel better and feel more secure if there was a tour guide (someone who could help navigate the unfamiliar territory). Don't worry, because everyone has a guide through the redemptive work of our Lord, Jesus Christ! In this text, Jesus was preparing the disciples for the Spirit of Truth (Holy Spirit) that would guide them and become their advocate. This Guide (Holy Spirit) also helps overcome daily struggles in life and reminds those, who believe, of the promises of God. Paul states, "Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God" [1 Cor 2:12 ESV]. Don't worry! Believers have a Guide sent from Jesus. who loves all. Luke reminds the followers of Jesus in Act 1:8 [ESV], "you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be

my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." [Act 1:8 ESV]. Believe and receive this gift from God.
